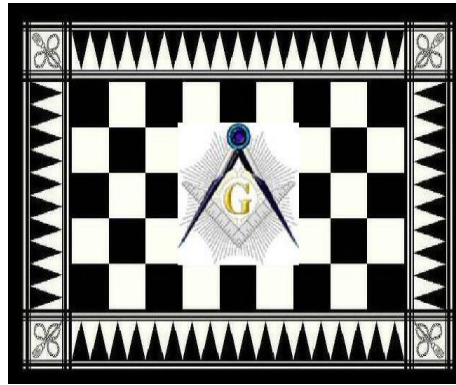

A Worshipful Master is a man that we have the utmost respect for and look to for leadership in the coming year. He is Worshipful to the Grand Architect of the Universe.

The Wardens are masons who sit in the West and the South and assist the Worshipful Master in his duties.

The Deacons sit on opposite sides of the Lodge. The Senior in the East who conducts candidates and sets up the altar in the center of the room. The Junior sits in the West, guards the door and informs the Tyler of the status of the Lodge.

The Tyler guards outside the door during private meetings, making sure only Masons with permission enter. He also assists preparing candidates for initiation.

The Stewards guard the Altar, make sure the temple is clean and assist with preparing and serving meals.

For those who are attending who are not masons, we hope this event will introduce you to a small part of who we are and what we do.

Masonic Terms:

So Mote It Be = Amen

Temple = The building containing the Lodge

Altar = The raised structure at the center of the Lodge containing the 3 Great Lights: The Holy Bible, Square and Compasses.

1 Rap = Calling a specific person, or officer, giving permission to speak or orders to the Lodge.

2 Raps = All Officers Stand

3 Raps = All Stand
